

Lemonade Watermelon Punch

- 1 large watermelon
- 1 - 12 oz. can frozen lemonade concentrate, thawed
- 2 cups water
- ¼ cup grenadine syrup
- 1 - 32 oz. bottle lemon lime soda, chilled

Select a melon about 20 inches long with a flat base. The day before serving cut an 8-inch oval section from the top of the melon. Remove cut portion and reserve. Using a long handled spoon, scoop out all pulp and remove seeds. Place about ¼ of the pulp in blender or food processor, cover and puree. Repeat with remaining pulp. Place melon shell on a tray. Return puree with melon shell. Stir in lemonade concentrate, water and grenadine. Replace cut portion of melon on top; refrigerate overnight. Just before serving, remove cut portion of melon, pour in lemon-lime soda to fill melon about ¾ full. Makes about 20 cups.
